

# INFORMATIONAL / CATECHETICAL INSTRUCTION #9

## A SERIES ON THE PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE ROMAN MISSAL (*Order of the Mass*) (Effective: Advent 2011) (August 23, 2009)

To more accurately reflect an authentic interpretation of the original Latin Rite, during the Eucharistic Prayer, the following is proposed for implementation in the U.S. Catholic Church on the first Sunday of Advent 2011:

<p>Mystery of Faith (formerly the Memorial Acclamation)</p>	<p><i>Priest:</i> <b>Let us proclaim the mystery of faith:</b></p> <p><i>People:</i> A – Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.</p> <p><i>or B – Dying you destroyed our death, rising you restored our life. Lord Jesus, come in glory.</i></p> <p><i>or C – When we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim your death, Lord Jesus, until you come in glory.</i></p> <p><i>or D – Lord, by your cross and resurrection, you have set us free. You are the Savior of the World.</i></p>	<p><i>Priest:</i> <b>The mystery of faith.</b></p> <p><i>People:</i> [Christ has died... a U.S. adaptation yet to be decided by Holy See]</p> <p>A – <b>We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again.</b></p> <p><i>or B – When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your death, O Lord, until you come again.</i></p> <p><i>or C – Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection, you have set us free.</i></p>
